Pasco County roads repair project delayed

~~Contractor working to find granite from out-of-state supplier~~

PASCO COUNTY, FL ---- Due to a granite supply shortage, the [Pasco County Public Works Department](#) is temporarily delaying the surface treatment work, until at least mid-June, 2017, for some county roads scheduled for repair.

The project contractor, Asphalt Paving Systems, was expected to complete the road work in the Holiday Hills, Cypress Knolls/Lakewood Ranches/Lakewood Villas/Richey Lakes, Bass Lake, Lake Worrell and Woodgate subdivisions by mid-June, but is having difficulty finding the granite needed for the chip seal application process. The granite has to be imported from an out-of-state source, delaying the continuation of the road repair work until mid-June or later.

The contractor has already applied an asphalt-looking product to level the surface on all roads that required it. The chip and fog seal applications will not be completed until the granite is available.
