The TDC, comprised of elected officials and tourism industry professionals, is responsible for providing oversight to Staff on the use of tourism taxes – also known as the 'Bed Tax'.

Council members serve staggered, four-year terms. The TDC typically meets on a monthly basis.

Some of the responsibilities of TDC members include: making recommendations to the BCC regarding the Special Event Marketing Program and Sport Event Sponsorship Program; overseeing department policies and procedures; providing funding allocation recommendations and serving as an advocate for tourism and destination development.
