PASCO COUNTY, FL ---- Pasco County Government is hosting three **countywide meetings** to educate and inform Pasco voters about four General Obligation Bond questions that will be listed on the November ballot after the Constitutional Amendments.

In November, Pasco County voters will have an opportunity to vote on four separate general obligation bond questions to fund improvement projects for the **Sheriff, Fire Rescue, Parks, and Libraries**.
