

Withlacoochee River Park

Withlacoochee River Park is situated on 458 acres of natural Florida wilderness. The park's amenities have been designed to enhance the quality of life for residents and visitors of Pasco County, and the recreational facilities and program opportunities are available for everyone to enjoy. Visitors can experience the pleasures of bird watching, hiking, camping, fishing, canoeing/kayaking and relaxing with nature.

The park offers the following amenities: A canoe/fishing dock, four picnic shelters with six tables, a large pavilion with 18 tables, a 50' observation tower, a Nature Center, and an Earth Stage in our 30-acre recreation field. There are also two playgrounds, nine miles of hiking trails, a 1.7-mile paved trail, and three restroom facilities.

The RV campground has a bathhouse restroom facility, a compost toilet is available in the primitive campground. Primitive campsites No. 1 through 7 can accommodate two tents with up to eight people. Semi-primitive campsites No. A through G can accommodate two tents with up to eight people. With the exception of semi-primitive campsites F and G, pets are not permitted in any tent or cabin site.

Two group campsites are available and each can accommodate up to 40 people. There are 15 RV campsites with water and 50, 30, and 20-amp electric. One 6-person Pioneer Cabin is available with electric.

One 4-person Primitive Cabin without electricity is also available. For your convenience a sanitary dump station is located in the recreation field.

Campers at Withlacoochee River Park will be given ten pieces of firewood per day (if available.) We recommend you bring additional wood, if you wish to enjoy a campfire requiring more than the ten pieces of wood allocated. Collecting firewood at Withlacoochee River Park is prohibited.

Please Note: All campers must be registered and set up prior to park closing.

The park is open seven days a week 7:00 a.m.-dusk (30 min. before dark.) To make reservations by credit card visit www.pascocountyfl.net or visit the park office to pay by cash or check.




Park Advisories

Collecting firewood at Withlacoochee River Park is prohibited. Generators, chainsaws, golf carts, and ATV's are also prohibited.

WARNING: Do not feed or handle any wildlife as this may result in serious injury or death.

Pet Owners: Florida's Leash Law applies to this park site. All pets must be on a leash (no more than six-foot long) at all times. Pet owners are required to pick after their pet. Remember, this is a nature park and there are wild animals sharing this space with you. Wild animals can be harmful to domestic animals. Be aware at all times and keep your pet safe.

Fishing: Florida Law requires all persons ages 16 and over to have a valid Florida Fishing License.

Do Not Tamper With Natural Objects: Pasco County Code, Sec. 70-37 states that no person shall destroy, injure, deface, mar, move, dig, harmfully disturb or remove from any park area or the waters thereof any soil, sand, gravel, rock, stone or other mineral, marine plant or animal, artifact or other material. No person shall cut, carve, injure, mutilate, move, displace or break off any water bottom formation or growth. No rope, wire or other contrivance, whether permanent or temporary, shall be attached to any natural feature or property within a park.
