

The Pasco County Parks, Recreation and Natural Resources Department supports rock decorating and hiding in our beautiful Pasco Parks. We encourage you to visit our parks to search for, and hide these fun pieces of art. There are a few simple ground rules you should know before you begin so that all rock explorers and park users remain safe.

1) Please refrain from placing rocks in open fields or in the grass (because of the mowers). This includes in the middle of athletic fields.

2) Please refrain from hiding rocks in areas that would create safety hazards. For example:

- Middle of bike paths
- In trees above reach level
- Near water
- Other locations that may present a danger

3) Rocks may not be placed in wetlands

4) Please refrain from placing rocks well off walking paths and bike trails.
