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Flood-related debris removal to end Monday, Sept. 26

~~Residents have until Friday, Sept. 23 to report storm-related debris~~

PASCO COUNTY, FL ---- Pasco County residents who still need to dispose of flood-related debris following Hurricane Hermine have until **Friday, September 23** to schedule a pick-up. Crews will be picking up debris from Hurricane Hermine debris in Pasco County every day through **Monday, September 26**.

Waste haulers have made several passes through affected areas to collect debris and Pasco County Emergency Management staff wants to make sure residents have one more weekend to get debris out to the curb.

Anyone who still has storm-related debris to dispose of should:

- Call **727.847.2411** or email customerservice@pascocountyfl.net by Friday, Sept. 23 at 5 p.m. to schedule debris removal.
- Place all debris at the curb, in separate piles of: furniture, construction materials, white goods (metal), and vegetation.

Residents can also take flood-damaged debris to the West Pasco Landfill at 14606 Hays Road in Spring Hill during normal business hours, Monday through Saturday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. **Fees will be waived through Saturday, October 15** for dumping storm-related items.
