## **Residential Curbside Trash/Recycling Suspension Lifted**

*~~Residents asked to secure trash/recycling and bins following Sat. pick-up~~*

**PASCO COUNTY, FL** ---- The suspension of **residential curbside** trash and recycling collection services **is being lifted, effective immediately**. Licensed haulers *will* pick up trash and recycling on regularly-scheduled routes Friday, September 8, 2017 and Saturday, September 9, 2017.

Pasco County is expected to receive tropical storm force winds late Saturday into Sunday, September 10, 2017. Residents are asked to **secure all trash and recycling bins** following Saturday's pick-up service.

Suspension of **commercial collection** service is **to be determined** on a case-by-case basis by each individual hauler. Commercial customers should contact their service provider for information.
