**PASCO COUNTY, FL** ---- The Pasco County Emergency Operations Center (EOC) is scaling back operations to Level Two Activation status. This means Pasco County EOC staff and other necessary County Government personnel will continue monitoring and responding to the rescue and recovery phases of Tropical Storm Hermine, and EOC operations will run daily from 7:00 a.m. to 7 p.m.
