PASCO COUNTY, FL ---- As the brunt of Tropical Storm Colin hits Pasco County, emergency officials are asking citizens to head home due to the possibility of high winds starting Monday afternoon.

“Our priority is making sure Pasco County residents are safe,” said Pasco County Administrator Michele Baker. “We’re asking everyone to be home safely and off the roads by 3 p.m. Monday afternoon.”

All Pasco County Government employees, who are not assigned to emergency duties, will be released at noon, Monday, June 6, 2016.
