Disaster Recovery Center to close in Pasco County

PASCO COUNTY, FL ---- The Pasco County Disaster Recovery Center (DRC) will close on Saturday October 29, 2016 at 12 noon. The DRC serves as one-stop shop for eligible Hurricane Hermine survivors seeking one-on-one help and assist affected residents and business owners with Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) registration.

FEMA and the Florida Division of Emergency Management (FDEM) will be scaling back operations in Pasco County, however residents can still receive information at the DRC from Pasco County on how to receive assistance from FEMA, FDEM, the U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) and state agencies.

The DRC is open from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. until Friday, October 28, 2016. It will be open from 9 a.m. to 12 noon on Saturday October 29, 2016.

Citizens are asked to bring the following items to properly register for assistance:

- Proof of ID and Residency (Driver's License, State ID, Utility Bills are examples)
- Proof of Home Ownership (if applicable)
- Insurance Coverage Information (if applicable)
- Photos/Documentation of Damages (if applicable)

Many services available at disaster recovery centers are also available by calling the FEMA helpline at 800-621-3362 even after the DRC closes. Survivors with questions regarding the application or the appeals process, or who need to register for assistance, may visit online at DisasterAssistance.gov or by phone (voice, 711 or relay service) at 800-621-3362. (TTY users should call 800-462-7585.) The toll-free lines are open 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. seven days a week. Multilingual operators are available.
