Pasco County EOC UPDATE (Friday 10/7/16)

~~Pasco County EOC back to monitoring mode~~

PASCO COUNTY, FL ---- The Pasco County Emergency Operations Center (EOC) is scaling back operations to Level Three Activation status. Pasco County EOC staff and other necessary County Government personnel will continue monitoring Hurricane Matthew and are prepared to respond to any citizen needs that may arise.

The Pasco County EOC has received a few reports of trees and power lines down, mainly on the eastern side of Pasco County.

The National Weather Service has canceled all Matthew-related watches and warnings for Pasco County as of Friday, October 7 at 11 a.m.

Pasco County has closed the hurricane shelter at Wiregrass Ranch High School in Wesley Chapel. 7 people and 1 dog came into the shelter last night. As of 10 a.m. Friday, the shelter was empty and Emergency Management staff made the decision to demobilize shelter operations.

Sandbag operations are no longer running in Pasco County; however, if conditions warrant opening sandbag sites again, staff is prepared to do so.
