Pasco County to close/cancel some services

~~County Offices closed to the public Friday, October 7 due to Hurricane Matthew~~

PASCO COUNTY, FL ---- Due to inclement weather expected from Hurricane Matthew, all residents are encouraged to use caution and to stay home, if possible, during the storm. In the interest of safety, some public offices and services will be closed or canceled Friday, October 7, 2016.

The following governmental agencies will be closed or are canceling services on **Friday, October 7, 2016:**

- All Pasco County Public Schools **closed** and after school activities **cancelled**
- Pasco County Government offices **closed to the public**
- All Pasco County Clerk and Comptroller offices will be **closed**, including courts
- Pasco County Health Department **closed**
- Pasco County Tax Collector – Dade City Office **closed**
- Pasco County Parks and Natural Resources camping areas at Crews Lake Wilderness Park, J.B. Starkey Wilderness Park, and Withlacoochee River Park **closed** until further notice

Cities/Municipalities **closed** Friday:

- St. Leo
- San Antonio
- Dade City
- Zephyrhills

Pasco County Public Transportation buses **will** operate Friday; however, in windy conditions, drivers will be using their own discretion as to whether to pull over and wait for weather conditions to improve.

All Pasco County Tax Collector Offices will be **open** Friday EXCEPT for the Dade City location.

All Supervisor of Elections Offices will be **open** Friday.
