NEW PORT RICHEY, FL ---- Pasco County is launching its annual online survey to solicit feedback from residents on a variety of topics related to the future of the County, such as transportation and growth. This information, combined with data from our random-sampling National Citizen Survey and our citizen listening sessions, provides input for prioritizing our planning efforts and budget allocations.
