Mr. Dobies made the contribution in memory of his beloved canine, Lucy, who passed away in 2012. The new and improved dog park at Anclote Gulf Park is scheduled to have its official grand opening on March 28, 2016 at 9:30 a.m. Residents are encouraged to join in the festivities and bring their dogs out for a fun-filled day.

Anclote Gulf Park has long been a popular destination for dogs and their owners and the new improvements are expected to draw even more visitors. Upgrades to the dog park include an additional fenced area for dogs of all sizes, more picnic tables and covered benches, dog water-fountains, and a canine agility play set. The park is located at 2305 Baillies Bluff Road, Holiday, Florida and is open from dawn to dusk, seven days a week.
