County Offices to close for Independence Day

PASCO COUNTY, FL ---- Pasco County Government offices, including the Constitutional Offices and the Courts, will be closed on Monday, July 4, 2016 in observance of Independence Day. All government offices and the courts will reopen on Tuesday, July 5, 2016.

The Pasco County Tax Collector's Office will be closed on Saturday, July 2 and Monday, July 4, 2016 in observance of Independence Day. The office will reopen on Tuesday, July 5, 2016 at 7:30am.

All Pasco County Libraries will open to the public on Tuesday, July 5, 2016, at their regularly – scheduled times.

The Pasco County Parks, Recreation, and Natural Resources' offices and Recreation Complexes will be closed on July 4, 2016; however, the parks and beaches will remain open to the public from dawn to dusk.

The Pasco County Animal Services Administration Office, Adoption Center, Intake/Reclaim Shelter and Field Services will be closed Monday, July 4, 2016 in observance of Independence Day. An Animal Control Officer will be available for emergencies only. The Adoption Center & Intake/Reclaim will resume regular business hours on Tuesday, July 5, 2016: Noon – 6:30pm; The Administration Office and Field Services of Animal Services will resume regular business hours on Tuesday, July 5, 2016, 8am – 5pm.

Pasco County Public Transportation – No bus service will run on Monday, July 4, 2016. PCPT will resume regular daily schedule on Tuesday, July 5, 2016.

The Pasco County Resource Recovery Facility, West Pasco Class III, and the East Pasco Transfer Station will be closed to the public on Monday, July 4, 2016; however, they will be open to Pasco County licensed commercial haulers only. The Resource Recovery Facility, West Pasco Class III, and the East Pasco Transfer Station will reopen to the public on Tuesday, July 5, 2016.
