PASCO COUNTY, FL ---- The Pasco County Tourist Development Council (TDC), and the Pasco Board of County Commissioners (BCC), are looking for a new team member who understands how important tourism is to Pasco County. The Pasco County Office of Tourism Development, Visit Pasco, is working hard to promote Pasco County, Florida as a tourist destination and it's paying off. The tourism taxes collected are up \$70,000 over this time last year. *(See previous press release below)*

“The Council is made up of elected officials and members of the hotel and hospitality sector and provides oversight to staff on the use of the ‘Bed Tax’,” explained Tourism Manager Ed Caum. “I’m hopeful we will have more of an interest and participation from our restaurateurs, as we look to fill the open seat on the council.”

Some of the responsibilities of TDC members include: making recommendations to the BCC regarding the Special Event Marketing Program and Sport Event Sponsorship Program; providing advice and consent in regards to department policies and procedures; and allocating funds and serving as an advocate for tourism and destination development.

Council members serve for staggered terms of four years. The TDC meets on a monthly basis.
