## **Vision 54/56 Phase 2 Task Force Meeting**

*~~Second meeting set for August 24, 2017~~*

**LAND O'LAKES, FL** ---- The [Pasco County Metropolitan Planning Organization \(MPO\)](#) is hosting its second public **Vision 54/56 Task Force Meeting** to continue evaluating transportation solutions for the State Road 54/56 Corridor, from U.S. 19 to Bruce B. Downs Boulevard. Anyone interested in the [Vision 54/56 Study](#) is invited to attend. Citizens will be able to listen to the task force discussion and take part in a public comment session.

This study is designed to determine the best solutions for addressing congestion, safety and mobility along the SR 54/56 Corridor. During Phase 1, the task force recommended six (6) major highway and transit alternatives, five (5) complementary alternatives and one (1) No-Build alternative. The MPO Board approved these alternatives for further evaluation in Phase 2 of the study.

During Phase 2, the task force will take a more detailed look at the recommended alternatives and complementary alternatives to ultimately select the preferred alternatives that support the vision for the SR 54/56 corridor.
