PASCO COUNTY, FL ---- Pasco County Animal Services (PCAS) is packed beyond belief with strays. The shelter has not been this full since the SAVE 90% program began! Animal intakes for this year are high; over 1,000 more animals have been taken in as compared to those from the same time period last year.

Pet overpopulation is not just a shelter problem, it's a community problem and PCAS is requesting help from champions in the community. With 171 dogs and 171 cats, Pasco County Animal Services needs everyone's help to find these animals homes. Please help spread the word! Please consider adopting an adorable new family member!

If you are missing your pet, please check the shelter. If you already have pets at home, love and care for them, and make sure that they are spayed/neutered, micro chipped, and wearing their County tag.

PCAS is a Save 90 shelter that strives to find loving homes for adoptable animals and not euthanize for space. With so many strays coming in and not enough adoptions or rescue pulls, there are not a lot of options. Many area shelters and rescue organizations are also at capacity.
