County Offices to close for Martin Luther King's Birthday

PASCO COUNTY, FL ---- Pasco County Government offices, including the Constitutional Offices and the Courts, will be closed on Monday, January 18, 2016 in observance of Martin Luther King's Birthday. All government offices and the courts will reopen on Tuesday, January 19, 2016.

The Pasco County Tax Collector's Office will be closed on Saturday, January 16, 2016 and Monday, January 18, 2016 in observance of Martin Luther King's Birthday. The office will reopen on Tuesday, January 19, 2016.

All Pasco County Libraries will be open on Tuesday, January 19, 2016.

The Pasco County Parks, Recreation, and Natural Resources' offices and Recreation Complexes will be closed on January 18, 2016; however, the parks and beaches will remain open to the public from dawn to dusk.

The Pasco County Animal Services Administration Office, Adoption Center, Intake/Reclaim Shelter and Field Services will be closed Monday, January 18, 2016, in observance of the Martin Luther King's Birthday. An Animal Control Officer will be available for emergencies only. The Adoption Center & Intake/Reclaim will resume regular business hours on Tuesday, January 19, 2016: Noon – 6:30pm; The Administration Office and Field Services of Animal Services will resume regular business hours on Tuesday, January 19, 2016, 8am – 5pm.

Pasco County Public Transportation (PCPT) will be closed on Monday, January 18, 2016, in observance of Martin Luther King Jr's Birthday and will not provide services. PCPT will resume services on Tuesday, January 19, 2016

The Pasco County Resource Recovery Facility, West Pasco Class III, and the East Pasco Transfer Station will be closed to the public on Monday, January 18, 2016; however they will be open to Pasco County licensed commercial haulers only. The Resource Recovery Facility, West Pasco Class III, and the East Pasco Transfer Station will reopen to the public on Tuesday, January 19, 2016.
