



FLASH REPORT 2-2016 – COLD WEATHER ALERT

CURRENT SITUATION:

A cold front will be moving into our area that will allow temperatures to fall into the upper 30's to around 40F tonight. These conditions will continue Tuesday overnight and early Wednesday morning and then begin a warming trend as we move toward weekend.

These low temperatures and wind chills are dangerous to anyone who will be outside for a long period of time. Children, the elderly, and pets are especially vulnerable to the cold and extra care should be taken to protect them. Make sure to bundle up and dress in layers to keep as warm as possible!
