County Offices to close for Staff Development Day

~Constitutional Offices to remain open~

PASCO COUNTY, FL ---- Several Pasco County Government offices will be closed to the public on Presidents' Day, Monday, February 15, 2016, for a Staff Development Day. All County Departments will be performing staff development activities throughout the day. Government offices will reopen to the public on Tuesday, February 16.

Pasco County Recreation Complexes and Community Centers will be closed to the public on Monday, February 15; however, the parks will remain open for public use.

A Pasco County Animal Control Officer will be on standby for emergency calls only. The Animal Shelter will reopen on Tuesday, February 16, at noon and will close at 6:30 p.m.

Also on Monday, February 15, the Pasco County Resource Recovery Facility and the East Pasco Transfer Station will be open to the general public and licensed commercial haulers.

Pasco County Public Transportation will be open and will run their regular bus routes on Monday, February 15.

The Clerk and Comptroller's Criminal (including Traffic violations) and Civil Court Divisions, Property Appraiser, Supervisor of Elections, Tax Collector, Sheriff's Office, and the Courts will still be open for business as usual on Monday.
