County Offices to close for Christmas Holiday

PASCO COUNTY, FL ---- Pasco County Government offices, including the Constitutional Offices will be closed on Monday, December 26, 2016 in observance of Christmas. All government offices and the courts will reopen on Tuesday, December 27, 2016.

The Pasco County Clerk and Courts will be closed on Friday, December 23, 2016 and Monday, December 26, 2016.

The Pasco County Tax Collector's Office will be closed on Saturday, December 24, 2016 and Monday, December 26, 2016. The office will reopen on Tuesday, December 27, 2016.

All Pasco County Libraries will be closed to the public on Saturday, December 24, 2016, Sunday, December 25, 2016 and Monday, December 26, 2016. Pasco County Libraries will reopen on Tuesday, December 27, 2016 with regular business hours.

The Pasco County Parks, Recreation, and Natural Resources' Offices and Recreation Complexes will be closed on Saturday, December 24, 2016, Sunday, December 25, 2016 and Monday, December 26, 2016; however, the parks and beaches will remain open to the public from dawn to dusk.

The Pasco County Animal Services Administration Office, Adoption Center, Intake/Reclaim Shelter and Field Services will be closed Monday, December 26, 2016. An Animal Control Officer will be available for emergencies only. The Adoption Center & Intake/Reclaim will close early – at 5 p.m. – on Saturday, December 24, 2016 and will reopen for regular business hours on Tuesday, December 27, 2016. The Animal Services Administration Office and Field Services will also resume regular business hours on Tuesday, December 27, 2016.

Pasco County Public Transportation (PCPT) will be closed and will not provide transportation services on Monday, December 26, 2016 in observance of Christmas.

The Pasco County Resource Recovery Facility, West Pasco Class III, and the East Pasco Transfer Station will be closed on Monday, December 26, 2016 to the public; however, they will be open to licensed commercial haulers. The Pasco County Resource Recovery Facility, West Pasco Class III, and the East Pasco Transfer Station will reopen to the public on Tuesday, December 27, 2016.
