PASCO COUNTY, FL --- Pasco County Emergency Communications is hiring Emergency Communications Officers - or 911 call takers. We have 19 positions available. When a 911 call is received by Public Safety Communications, an Emergency Communications Officer triages the call using a state-of-the-art computerized dispatch system to ensure an appropriate response to each call for service. The Communications Officer is the first person to help people when they dial 911 – gathering vital information for first responders.
