Pasco County Commissioner Jack Mariano, Public Infrastructure staff and FGUA representatives will be available to discuss the project.

- Addressing residential concerns, environmental impact and the development of each site with an interconnection of wastewater services into the Pasco Utilities system.
- Decommissioning and demolishing both wastewater treatment facilities to address issues that occur during extreme weather events.
- Improving surface water and, indirectly, groundwater quality in the area.
