The purpose of the meeting is to present plans for the Navigation Center to neighbors and business owners, and to provide an opportunity for feedback and questions.

The [Coalition for the Homeless of Pasco County](#) would operate the proposed Navigation Center located at [8239 Youth Lane](#) in New Port Richey.

The proposed center would provide temporary housing (typically 4 to 8 weeks) for families. The Navigation Center would also provide job training; resume building; financial literacy services; case management; and basic healthcare.
