Pasco Hosts Coastal Risk Map Open House Featuring New Flood Maps

HUDSON, FL ---- Is your property at risk for flooding? Do you need flood insurance? New, preliminary Flood Insurance Rate Maps ([FIRM](#)s) will be available for viewing at [Pasco County](#)'s Coastal Risk Map Open House on **August 30, 2018 from 6 p.m. to 9 p.m.** at the Hudson Regional Library.

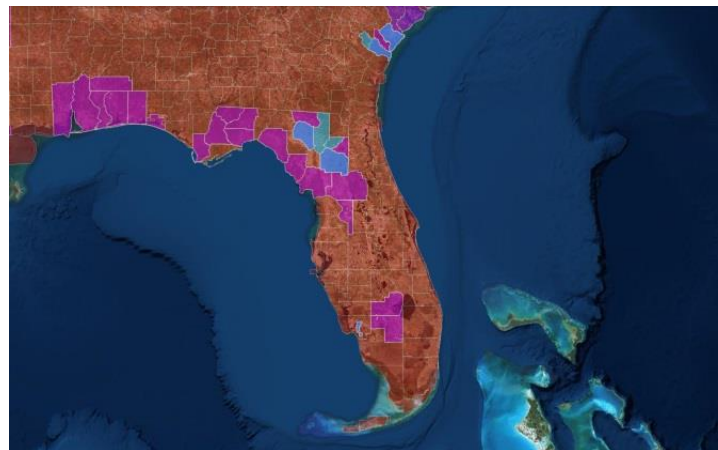
Approximately 28,000 parcels in Pasco's coastal communities will see some change in base flood elevation or flood zone. Residents and property owners are encouraged to attend.

The new Federal Emergency Management Agency ([FEMA](#)) Flood Insurance Rate Maps are based on revised coastal flood modeling and used to determine a property's flood risk and flood insurance requirements. Specialists will be on hand to answer questions regarding flood risk, flood insurance, the appeal process and the mapping methods used to make the new maps.
