PASCO COUNTY, FL ---- Help [Pasco County Code Enforcement](#) Officers keep your community safe and looking beautiful – anonymously! Code Enforcement is now accepting **anonymous code violation complaints**, allowing your voice to be heard while maintaining your privacy.

“This will allow our community members to feel comfortable filing a complaint about an issue they otherwise might hesitate to report,” said Code Enforcement Manager Micah Tharpe.

Reporting an issue is easy and convenient on the [MyPasco App](#). You can upload photos and indicate problem areas on a locator map – without having to give your name, address or phone number.

You can also contact Pasco County Customer Service at 727.847.2411 or online at [bit.ly/PC-CustomerService](#) to report issues such as:

- ✓ Yards being used as a storage area for junk or debris
- ✓ Inoperative/unlicensed vehicles
- ✓ Unmaintained swimming pool
- ✓ Illegal dumping
- ✓ Noise violation

Code Enforcement Officers handle most complaints within 7-10 business days, and are often able to resolve issues without issuing a citation.
