Pasco County Opens Sandbagging Stations

PASCO COUNTY, FL ---- As Hurricane Michael approaches Florida, Pasco County Government is opening sandbag stations to help residents protect their property from potential flooding. Sandbag operations will begin today, Monday, October 8, 2018. The following locations will be open 24 hours a day, until further notice:

- **Fire Station #17**, 2951 Seven Springs Blvd, New Port Richey (**Opens at 1 p.m.**)
- **Veterans Memorial Park**, 14333 Hicks Rd, Hudson (**Opens at 1 p.m.**)
- **Magnolia Valley Golf Course Clubhouse**, 7223 Massachusetts Ave, New Port Richey
- **C-Barn**, 30908 Warder Road, San Antonio

* Note: Sandbag locations are self-serve and are open to Pasco County residents. Residents should be prepared to fill their own sandbags, although various sandbag sites might have inmate assistance available during normal business hours. Sandbags are provided, but residents are encouraged to bring their own shovels. Sand will be refilled only between the hours of 8 a.m. – to 5 p.m.
