Pasco County Offices to Close for Christmas

PASCO COUNTY, FL ---- Pasco County Government offices, including the Constitutional Offices and the Courts, will be closed Monday, December 24, 2018, and Tuesday, December 25, 2018, in observance of Christmas. All government offices and the Courts will reopen Wednesday, December 26, 2018.

The **Pasco County Parks, Recreation, and Natural Resources**' Offices, Recreation Complexes and Community Centers will be closed Monday, December 24, 2018, and Tuesday, December 25, 2018; however, the parks and beaches will stay open to the public from dawn to dusk.

Pasco County **Public Transportation (PCPT)** will be **open** Monday, December 24, 2018; however, **Route 19** will run a <u>shortened schedule</u>, ending at 8:25 p.m. PCPT administrative offices will be closed to walk-in customers Monday, December 24, 2018; however, phone lines will be open. All Pasco County **Libraries** will be **closed** Saturday, December 22, 2018; Monday, December 24, 2018; and Tuesday, December 25, 2018.

The Pasco County **Animal Services** Administration Office, Adoption Center, Intake/Reclaim Shelter and Field Services will be closed Monday, December 24, 2018, and Tuesday, December 25, 2018. An Animal Control Officer will be available for emergencies only.

The Pasco County **Resource Recovery Facility**, West Pasco Class III, and the East Pasco **Transfer Station** will be closed to the public Monday, December 24, 2018; however they will be open to Pasco County licensed commercial haulers. The Pasco County Resource Facility, West Pasco Class III, and the East Pasco Transfer Station will be closed to the public and Pasco County Licensed haulers Tuesday, December 25, 2018.
