## **Pasco County Legislative Day in Tallahassee**

*~~Commissioners to meet with state lawmakers; discuss 2019 legislative priorities~~*

**PASCO COUNTY, FL** ---- Pasco County Commissioners will travel to Tallahassee this week for **Pasco County Legislative Day**. Commissioners will meet with the Pasco County Legislative Delegation **Wednesday, March 13, 2019**, to advocate for Pasco's [2019 State Legislative Agenda Priorities](#).

The day will begin with a *Coffee with the County* event hosted by the Pasco County Legislative Delegation. Commissioners will then spend the afternoon meeting with state lawmakers and their staff on Capitol Hill, and sitting in on Capitol sessions and committee meetings. In the evening, board members will attend a reception honoring the Pasco Legislature.

Some of the board's 2019 State Legislative Agenda Priorities include:

- ✓ The Starkey Trail (Starkey Gap) at S.R. 54 Trail Crossing – \$4M
- ✓ Gateways Beautification Plan – \$3.4M
- ✓ Millers Bayou Working Waterfront Enhancements – \$3M
- ✓ Land O' Lakes Redevelopment Plan – \$1.5M

The 2019 Legislative Session began March 5 and runs through May 3.
