**DADE CITY, FL** ---- The UF/IFAS [Pasco County Cooperative Extension Service](#) is offering a full-day **Cottage Foods Workshop** on **April 5, 2019**, at the One Stop Shop Stallings building. Cottage foods include cakes, loaf breads, jams, popcorn and more produced for sale in a home kitchen. Florida law allows this production of certain items that present a low risk of foodborne illness.
