PASCO COUNTY, FL ---- Following days of heavy rain, and more rain in the forecast for the weekend, [Pasco County Government](#) would like to remind everyone there are two sandbag stations open to help you protect your property from potential flooding. Sand and sandbags are available at the following locations:

- **Pasco County Public Works (C-Barn)**

- **Magnolia Valley Golf Course Clubhouse**
[7223 Massachusetts Ave.](#), New Port Richey



These are self-serve sandbag locations and they are open 24 hours to Pasco County residents. Please bring a shovel and be prepared to fill your own sandbags.
