## **Animal Services Temporarily Suspends Vaccine, Microchip Clinics**

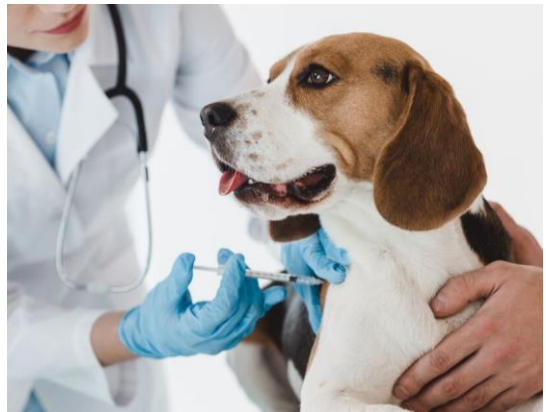
*~~Services resume December 4, 2019, with free rabies vaccinations for the first 50 pets~~*

**LAND O' LAKES, FL** ---- [Pasco County Animal Services](#) (PCAS) is temporarily suspending vaccine and microchip clinic services beginning October, 16, 2019, due to a veterinarian staffing shortage. PCAS appreciates your patience during this interruption, and is pleased to offer free rabies vaccinations to the first 50 clients when **services resume December 4, 2019.**

This temporary interruption affects only the vaccine and microchip clinics. The veterinary team remains focused on the medical needs of the shelter and preparing pets for adoption and rescue.

### **Be among the first 50 for a free vaccine December 4:**

1. Email us at: [adoptionpartners@mypasco.net](mailto:adoptionpartners@mypasco.net) with your name and how many pets you plan to bring.
2. You will be contacted by a PCAS staff member to confirm eligibility for a free vaccination.
3. Please bring a government-issued ID and previous rabies vaccination history on Dec. 4.



To assist with a quick check-in when clinic services resume Wednesday, December 4, 2019, the PCAS representative may ask you to complete a pet/owner information form in advance. Pasco County residents will be required to purchase a county license for their pets.
