PASCO COUNTY, FL ---- [Pasco County Commissioners](#) will travel to Tallahassee this week for **Pasco County Legislative Day** Wednesday, January 15, 2020, to advocate for Pasco’s [2020 State Legislative Agenda Priority Issues](#).

Commissioners will spend the day meeting with the Pasco County Legislative Delegation, state lawmakers and leadership in the Florida Legislature, and attending committee meetings. In the evening, board members will attend a reception honoring the Florida Legislature.

Some of the board’s 2020 State Legislative Agenda Priorities include:

- ✓ Pasco-Hernando State College Berm/Boggy Creek – \$3.2M
- ✓ Mitchell Ranch Road Drainage Improvement Plan – \$475K
- ✓ Quail Hollow Blvd. South Drainage Improvements– \$850K
- ✓ Arthur Engle Park Multi-Use Fields – \$5.9M

The 2020 Legislative Session begins January 14 and runs through March 13.
