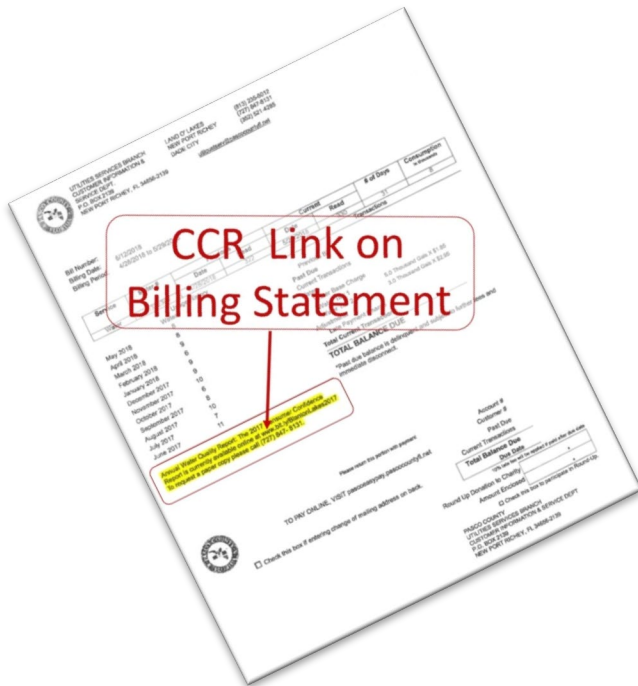
## **Pasco County Utilities Water Quality Reports Now Available Online**
