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Darlington Rd. Bridge Temporary Closure, Erosion Control Project

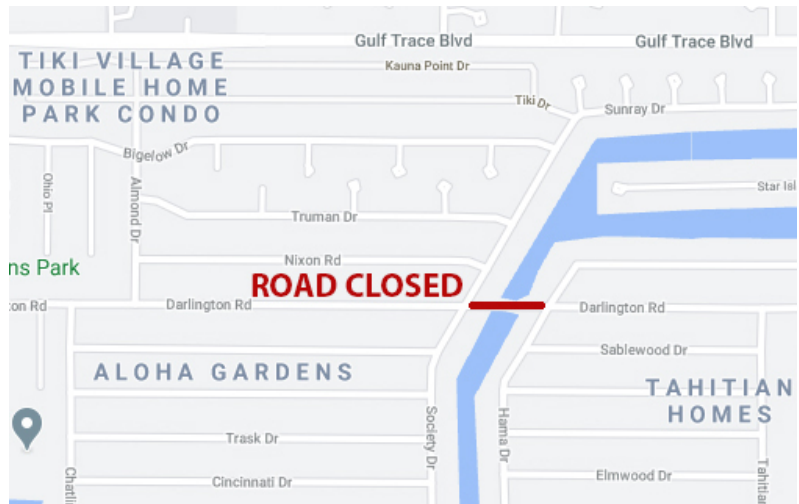
~~Daytime work begins November 3, 2020, construction expected to last three days~~

HOLIDAY, FL ---- The **Darlington Road Bridge Erosion Control Project** is scheduled to begin **November 3, 2020** and will require complete closure of the bridge during daytime work hours. Crews will be installing erosion control matting around the stormwater pipe beneath the bridge.

Both the eastbound and westbound lanes of Darlington Road between Hama Drive/Baden Drive and Society Drive will be subject to closure. Traffic west of the bridge will be detoured northbound using Society Drive and Sunray Drive for access to U.S. Highway 19.

Project Details:

- Work hours are scheduled for Tuesday through Thursday, 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- Expect full lane closures with message boards directing traffic.
- Project is expected to take three workdays, depending upon weather conditions.
- Target completion date is November 5, 2020.
