DOH-PASCO MOVES REGISTRATION DAY FOR COVID-19 VACCINATION APPOINTMENTS

PASCO COUNTY, Fla. – The Florida Department of Health in Pasco County (DOH-Pasco) is moving the day on when appointments will open for the COVID-19 vaccination.

Beginning this **Friday, April 2nd** and ongoing, vaccination appointments for first doses will **open for registration at 2:00 p.m.** instead of Sunday's. An appointment is **mandatory** to receive the COVID-19 vaccination. Please be aware that the demand for the COVID-19 vaccine is greater than the supply we have on hand, so appointments for vaccination fill up very quickly appointments will open for registration at 2:00pm.

Beginning Monday, April 5, **all** Floridians will be eligible to receive COVID-19 as prescribed by the Food and Drug Administration.

It is required to have a photo I.D. when checking in for all vaccination appointments. If the online patient portal was used to register for an appointment (instead of calling), those people should bring a printed or digital copy of the confirmation email they received containing a QR code.

The statewide COVID-19 vaccine registration system is also available. Florida residents can go online to MyVaccine.FL.gov or call 866-201-7092 to be put on a waitlist that is being run by state sponsored sites. More COVID-19 vaccine is becoming available, and community partners – including retail pharmacies, hospital systems and physician's offices – are beginning to receive COVID-19 vaccine and put infrastructure in place to vaccinate Pasco County residents.
