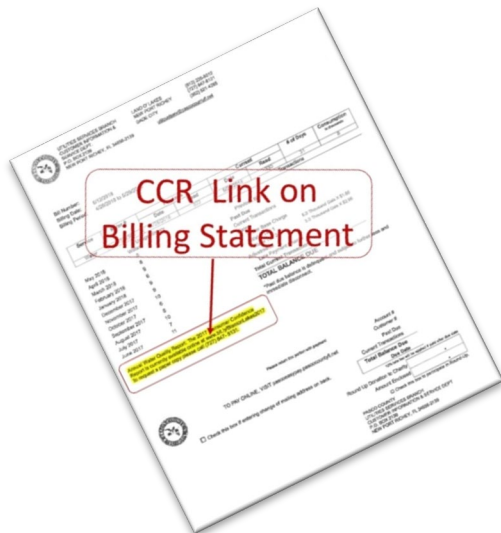
Pasco County Utilities Water Quality Reports Available Online

Water supplied by Pasco County Utilities is closely monitored and meets or exceeds all Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) regulations for the treatment requirements of a public water system. Treatment prevents waterborne pathogens – such as viruses – from contaminating drinking water and includes filtration and disinfectants that remove or kill pathogens before they ever reach your tap.
