Pasco Board of County Commissioners Undergoes Reorganization *~~BCC names new Chair/Vice-Chair~~*

PASCO COUNTY, FL ---- The [Pasco Board of County Commissioners](#) (BCC) reorganized at its regular meeting December 7, 2021, in New Port Richey. The board elected Commissioner Kathryn Starkey to serve as board chair and Commissioner Jack Mariano to serve as vice chair.

“It’s an honor to have been appointed the new chair,” Starkey said. “I’m proud of what the board has accomplished so far and look forward to continuing our work to make Pasco County the best place to live, work and play.”

The BCC consists of the following members:

The BCC also voted to adopt new [county commission districts](#) as required every 10 years following the U.S. Census. There are five commission districts in Pasco County, and each is nearly equal in proportion to population size. The new districts went into effect December 7, 2021.
