Pasco County Tornado Debris Removal Guidelines

- Pasco County will begin picking up storm debris Wednesday, April 13, 2016 *only* in those areas directly impacted by the tornado that touched down early April 7th in the West Pasco area.
- ALL storm debris **MUST** be lined up along the side of the road no later than 7:00 a.m. Wednesday, April 13.
- Crews will *only* pick up two types of storm debris, **which MUST be piled separately**:
 - 1) Branches from downed trees; other vegetation that could attract bugs/rodents
 - 2) Building materials blown apart by wind - including roofing, aluminum, awnings, etc., that could present a safety hazard
- Pasco County Crews will **NOT** pick up any hazardous materials, appliances, electronics, furniture, carpet, cabinetry, garbage, etc.
- Residents who would like to take storm debris to the landfill themselves, will **NOT** be charged for this service; you **WILL** be required to give your name, address and phone number to ensure debris came from the affected area
