- Old Fishing Village with artsy
- Florida Fishing Village (PR Resident)
- Let businesses decide their style but build the trail under the bridge and move forward.
- Other Side [Connect to the other side of the river]
- East side transitional to across canal. West side modern-townhomes
- Connect to south side trail along bridge
- Village... Hip/Modern Classic...Repurpose Materials
- Tie to boat slips
- Casino. Waster sports theme. McCray’s Homosassa [McRae’s, Homosassa] Modern recreational
- Key West style tie in to existing businesses. Tin roofs, tiki bars, bright colors and lush landscape.
