

Pasco County Community Development Department State Housing Initiative Partnership (SHIP)

Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA)

Pasco County has received notice of award in the amount of \$791,041 in SHIP funding. Beginning October 21, 2019 and ending June 30, 2020 applications will periodically be accepted from citizens, non-profits and in some cases for-profit agencies to receive funds. Applications will be accepted only during the application period specified as each strategy is implemented. Please note that applications will only be accepted as long as budgeted funds for the strategy are available.

Pasco County will expend SHIP funds for 2019-2020 under the following Local Housing Assistance Plan LHAP Strategies:

- Pasco Opportunity Program
- Homebuyer Assistance Program
- Owner-Occupied Rehabilitation
- Demolition/Reconstruction
- Disaster Repair/Mitigation
- Foreclosure Prevention/Tax Payment Assessments
- New Construction
- Special Needs – Rental Subsidy Program
- Rental Assistance – Eviction Prevention
- Rental Rehabilitation
- Disaster Mitigation – Rental
- Land Acquisition/New Construction Rental
- Security and/or Utility Deposits/Rapid ReHousing
