Overview

The Pasco-Hernando Workforce Board, Inc. is a not-for-profit organization that serves Pasco and Hernando counties by administering local workforce development and welfare reform programs through State and Federal initiatives. We are one of 24 Local Workforce Boards in Florida operating under the governance of CareerSource Florida, which was created in 2000 by the Workforce Innovation Act.

The Local Workforce Boards share a common goal of developing the state's business climate by designing and implementing strategies to help our residents enter, remain, and advance in the workforce. Our focus is on Employment, Education, and Economic Development.

Our Mission

Pasco-Hernando Workforce Board, Inc., dba CareerSource Pasco Hernando, enhances economic development efforts of our region by providing a well-trained, high quality workforce which supports the success of local business and improves the quality of life.

CareerSource Pasco Hernando provides workforce and business development programs in the two county region. From programs designed specifically for local businesses to job seeker programs, Pasco-Hernando Workforce Board meets the needs of the workforce in our region.

Vacancies

Notice is hereby given that applications are being accepted from individuals qualified to fill a vacancy under the category of Education, defined by Local Workforce Development Board Composition, Certification and Decertification Policy Number 91 (CareerSource Florida), as:

“representatives of entities administering education and training activities in the local area, including...a private education provider”.

Additionally, there are vacancies under the Business category, defined by Policy 91, referenced above, as:

“owners of a business, chief executives or operating officers of businesses, or other business executives or employers with optimum policymaking or hiring authority; represent businesses, including small businesses, or organizations representing businesses that provide employment opportunities that, at a minimum, include high-quality, work-relevant training and development in in-demand industry sectors or occupations in the local area; and are appointed from among individuals nominated by local business organizations and business trade associations”.

This is a voluntary, non-paid position and members of the Board are eligible to serve for (3) three consecutive four-year terms. The Board meets on a quarterly basis and the meetings are conducted via teleconference.
