Section 125.0104(4)(e), Fla. Stat., created an advisory council to be known as the Pasco County Tourist Development Council. The Council shall be composed of nine members who shall be appointed by the Board of County Commissioners.

The Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners shall appoint a County Commissioner to serve as the Chairman to the Council. Two members of the Council shall be elected municipal officials, at least one of which shall be from the most populous municipality. Six members of the Council shall be persons who are involved in the tourist industry and who have demonstrated an interest in tourist development.

All members of the Council shall be qualified electors of the County. The members of the Council shall serve for staggered terms of four years.

We meet at minimum quarterly, but lately the schedule has been at least eight times a year due to an increase in business.
