Pasco County Animal Services (PCAS) panhandle shelter after the impact of hurricane Sally



After the effects of hurricane Sally in the Florida panhandle in the month of September, Santa Rosa County Animal Services in Pensacola, FL reached out to shelters all across the state for assistance. [Pasco County Animal Services \(PCAS\)](#) jumped into action and was able to travel over 12 hours and 875 miles to help rescue 14 dogs and puppies into the care of the shelter in Land O Lakes. The dogs/puppies were all examined by the veterinary team and cared for by the shelter team before being transferred to local rescue groups who also committed to helping the shelter partner.
