NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING OF THE PASCO COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT CORONAVIRUS AID RELIEF AND ECONOMIC SECURITY ACT (CARES ACT) FUNDING COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT - CORONAVIRUS (CDBG-CV) PROPOSED STATEMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT OBJECTIVES AND PROJECTED USE OF FUNDS

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has awarded Pasco County Entitlement Funds to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus pandemic (COVID-19). As an entitlement community, Pasco County receives CDBG, HOME and ESG funds from HUD on an annual basis. Pasco County has received an additional \$1,996,434 allocation of CDBG-CV funds. These special CDG-CV funds will be utilized to prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus.

The projects approved for COVID-19 funds will be included in a Substantial Amendment to the One-Year Action Plan for Program Year 2020 to be responsive to the needs in the community.

A public hearing is scheduled for **Wednesday, June 23, 2021, at 11:00 a.m.** at 8610 Galen Wilson Boulevard, Port Richey, Florida 34668 in the Community Development Conference Room. The purpose of this hearing is to review the projects to be recommended for funding by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC), the appropriation of which are scheduled for final BCC approval on July 6, 2021. Members of the public attending the hearing are advised that all social distancing requirements by the CDC and posted signage will be strictly observed.
