Stormwater Permit

The Stormwater Permit has been developed to meet Pasco County's new National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit requirements for erosion and sediment control inspections, on construction sites that require building permits.

The Permit requires the County to complete a minimum of three inspections for every construction site: A Pre-inspection, Mid-inspection (50% completion), and Final inspection. All inspections are to be performed by County personnel.

The Stormwater Permit will be issued by Central Permitting, to track the erosion and sediment control inspections and will be part of the Building Permitting Process.

Owner or Authorized agent may schedule the Pre- Inspections ONLINE at <http://secure.pascocountyfl.net/bccpapa/> or call 727-834-3611, when all erosion control BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES (BMPs) have been installed and at least 24 hrs.prior to any earthwork moving activities. Please assure that the County approved plans are posted on the site. No Earthwork activities can be performed until first inspection, subject to \$500 fine per day!!!

Mid and Final inspections may also be scheduled ONLINE using the same process or by calling 727-834-3611. The mid-Inspection is to be scheduled when it is estimated that 50% of the earthwork activities have occurred. The Final-Inspection is to be scheduled only after all exposed earth has been stabilized and any temporary BMP's have been removed.

Never should the Mid and Final Inspections be scheduled at the same time!! This may result in a \$500 per day fine.
